NOTICE TO BIDDERS
ADVERTISEMENT

NOTICE is hereby given that on Tuesday, May 7, 2013, sealed proposals will be received by the Township of Upper at Township Hall, 2100 Tuckahoe Road, Petersburg, New Jersey, at the hour of 1:00 PM prevailing time, for FURNISHING AND DELIVERY OF 2013 or NEWER REFUSE COLLECTION VEHICLES, REFUSE CONTAINERS AND RFID EVENT CAPTURE SYSTEM FOR UPPER TOWNSHIP, at which place and time the said bids will be publicly opened and read.

Specifications may be obtained at the office of the Township Clerk, Township Hall, 2100 Tuckahoe Road, Petersburg, New Jersey or via email at clerk@uppertownship.com. Bids will be accepted for Refuse Collection Vehicles, Refuse Containers and RFID Capture & Computer System.

Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope and plainly marked in the lower quadrant: FURNISHING AND DELIVERY OF 2013 or NEWER REFUSE COLLECTION VEHICLES, REFUSE CONTAINERS AND RFID EVENT CAPTURE SYSTEM FOR UPPER TOWNSHIP. The name and address of the bidders shall be on the envelope.

The form of bid supplied by the Township of Upper must be used in bidding. Award may be given to multiple bidders for each of the items listed on the Form of Bid.

Bids must be submitted prior to the time designated above for receipt and opening of bids, and must be submitted either by mail or in person by the bidder or his agent. No bids will be received after the time designated above for their receipt.

Bids must be addressed to the Township Committee, Township of Upper, 2100 Tuckahoe Road, Petersburg, New Jersey, 08270. Each bidder must deposit with his bid a certified check, cashiers check, or bid bond in the amount of ten (10) percent of the total lump sum bid. The right is reserved to reject any or all bids or to waive minor irregularities in any bid presented. Award, if any, will be made to the lowest and best responsible bidder at a formal meeting of Township Committee.

No bidder may withdraw his bond within 60 days after the actual date of opening.

The authority to award the bid shall be contingent upon no protest being signed by any person, nor any petition requesting that a referendum vote be taken, within 20 days after the publication or at any other time after the adoption of Ordinance No. 005-2013. The authority to award the bid is subject to and contingent upon said bond ordinance taking effect as provided by the Local Bond Law.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S. 105-31 (P.L. 1974, C. 127, Law Against Discrimination Affirmative Action Supplement). Bidders are required to submit a statement of ownership with the bid, in compliance with N.J.S. 52:25-24.2 (P.L. 1977, C. 33).
