**RE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 021-2018 KNOWN AS
THE SALARY ORDINANCE FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2019**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Upper, in the County of Cape May and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No.021-2018, known as the Salary Ordinance of 2019 is hereby amended as hereinafter provided for the line item as indicated below:

SECTION 3: Ordinance No.021-2018, known as the Salary Ordinance of 2019 is hereby amended to add the following as hereinafter provided:

E. PUBLIC WORKS/SPORTS AND RECREATION PROGRAMS:

<u>Supervising Carpenter</u>	<u>\$12,500.00</u>	<u>\$ 75,000.00</u>

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effects to the section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: REPEALER: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication as required by law.
