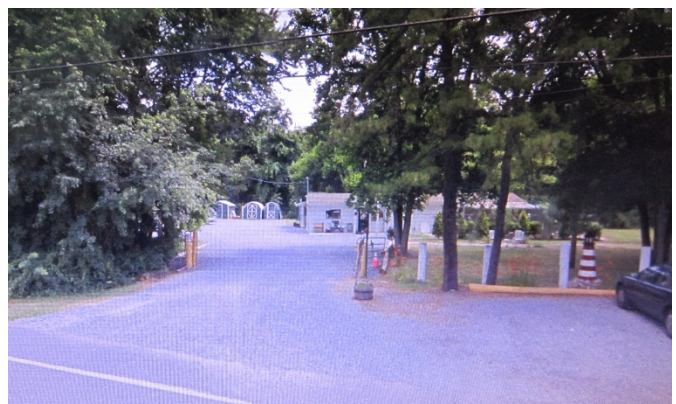
- Volunteers in Medicine (VIM)
