ORDINANCE NO. 015-2019

RE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCE

CHAPTER VII OF THE CODE OF UPPER TOWNSHIP TO PROVIDE FOR MANDATORY PENALTIES FOR TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee, in the Township of Upper, County of Cape May and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 7, Section 7-4, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Upper, also known as the Code of Upper Township, shall be amended and replaced in its entirety with the following:

7-4 TRUCKS OVER FIVE (5) TONS EXCLUDED FROM CERTAIN STREETS

Trucks over five (5) tons gross weight are hereby excluded from the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule V except for the pick up and delivery of materials on such streets, Schedule V being attached to and made a part of this Chapter.

SECTION 2. Chapter 7, Section 7-20, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Upper, also known as the Code of Upper Township, shall be amended and replaced in its entirety with the following:

7-20 PENALTY

7-20.1 Mandatory penalties for traffic violations

The following mandatory fines or penalties are hereby established for the offenses hereinafter set forth:

7-20.2 Ordinance violations where court appearance is required

Mandatory court appearances shall be required for those offenses noted below and the penalties for violation of any such ordinance provision shall be a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment for a term not to exceed fifteen (15) days or both. Any term of imprisonment may be served in community service in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 3. REPEALER: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict only.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, subsection, clause or provision declared invalid and the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall be enforceable.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication as required by law.

SECTION 6. CODIFICATION: This Ordinance shall be codified in the Upper Township Code at the sections referred to above.
