ORDINANCE NO. 012-2023

**RE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCE
CHAPTER 7 (TRAFFIC) AND CHAPTER 7A (TRAFFIC SCHEDULES)
OF THE CODE OF UPPER TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, the Township of Upper (the “Township”) desires to establish parking standards for parking near crosswalks, intersections and stop signs in the City of Strathmere for the safety and wellbeing of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Township also desires to amend Chapter 7A, Schedule I (entitled “No Parking”) as contained herein.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee, in the Township of Upper, County of Cape May and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. A Chapter 7-17 is hereby established in the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Upper, also known as the Code of Upper Township, titled “PARKING NEAR CROSSWALKS, INTERSECTIONS AND STOP SIGNS IN STRATHMERE” as hereinafter provided:

**§ 7-17 – PARKING NEAR CROSSWALKS, INTERSECTIONS AND STOP
SIGNS IN STRATHMERE**

Within the confines of Strathmere, except where necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a traffic of police officer or traffic sign or signal and except in a school zone during hours when school is in session, no operator of a vehicle shall stand or park the vehicle in any of the following places:

- A. Within five (5) feet of the nearest crosswalk or side line of a street or intersecting highway, except at alleys;
- B. Within twenty-five (25) feet of a stop sign.

SECTION 2. Chapter 7A, Schedule I (entitled “No Parking”) of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Upper, also known as the Code of Upper Township, shall be supplemented as hereinafter provided:

SCHEDULE I – NO PARKING

Add to include the following:

Name of Street	Direction
Commonwealth Avenue (CR 619)*	West side (south bound direction) Beginning at the southerly approach joint of the Corson’s Inlet Bridge and extending south for a distance of 108 LF.
	East Side (north bound direction) Beginning at the southerly approach joint of the Corson’s Inlet Bridge and extending south for a distance of 40 LF.

** No Parking designation was approved and authorized by the Cape May County Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Resolution No.493-23 and may be enforced by this Township ordinance.*

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the following publication as required by law.

SECTION 4: REPEALER: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, subsection, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, subsection, clause, or provision declared invalid and the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect and shall be enforceable.

SECTION 6: CODIFICATION: This Ordinance shall be codified in the Upper Township Code at the sections referred to above.
