**PUBLIC NOTICE  
NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Upper, in the County of Cape May, State of New Jersey, on February 2, 2026. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Township Hall, 2100 Tuckahoe Road, Petersburg New Jersey 08270, on February 23, 2026 at 6:30 p.m. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

**Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS 2026 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS BY AND IN THE TOWNSHIP OF UPPER, IN THE COUNTY OF CAPE MAY, STATE OF NEW JERSEY; APPROPRIATING \$5,143,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$4,898,094 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF**

**Purpose(s): Various 2026 Capital Improvements Including, But Not Limited To, Road Improvements; Architectural Design For Beach Patrol Headquarters; The Acquisition Of Various Equipment And/Or Vehicles For The Department Of Public Works; Various Improvements To Township Buildings and Grounds Including, But Not Limited To, Reconstruction Of Township Skate Park And Fitness Court And Acquisition And Installation Of Lighting For Amanda's Field; And The Acquisition Of Radio Equipment For The Public Safety Department**
